Future of Work Summer Research Scholarship

The Center for Future Work Places and Practices (CFWPP) is a transdisciplinary research center at Virginia Tech. The center is committed to integrating research and education perspectives to enhance the impact of emerging technologies on the future of work. CFWPP is pleased to announce its inaugural **Future of Work Summer Research Scholarship**.

Eligibility: Rising seniors and rising juniors at Virginia Tech will have priority determined by class level. Interested students should identify and work with an affiliated CFWPP faculty member to develop a research project that can be completed over the summer. The research projects should align with one or more of CFWPP's four research focus areas:

- Workforce development
- Health in the workplace
- Responsible technologies at work
- Sustainable work

Selected students will be affiliated with CFWPP and expected to give a presentation on their research projects at the start of the fall semester.

Selected students will receive a \$500 scholarship award in the Fall and a Certificate of Completion at the end of the project. The faculty supervisors will also receive \$500 that will be paid into a research account.

All applications must be completed by 5:00pm on Friday, May 24.
